Rules

- Students must be enrolled in a graphic arts program in New England. The work must have been produced by the student (from native file through finished product) within the graphics arts program.
- Pieces printed from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 are eligible for entry.
- Entries must reach the PINE office, **no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, January 28, 2022.**
- Only those entries exhibiting technical superiority are considered, and judges eliminate any pieces with obvious flaws, such as hickies, streaking, hazing, scratches, mottling, slurring, etc.
- Entries should not be mounted.
- PINE reserves the right to re-categorize any entry if it is determined that it would be judged more fairly.
- Winners will be notified via their instructor after judging is completed in February.

How to Submit Entries

- Go to pine.org/events/awards and complete the form using full names of schools, instructors and students, etc. Give each entry a unique name that helps to identify it.
- Choose two samples of each entry and review for imperfections.
- Check spelling, spacing, punctuation, etc. If the entry wins, the information you provided will be used to generate your award.
- Print out your packing slips.
- Attach packing slips to matching entries (do not use staples, paperclips, or tape to attach packing slips directly to entries).
- Please keep a copy of your packing slips for your records.

Returns

We understand that you might have a "one of a kind" item to submit (please let this be the exception, not the rule).
